Together with his Paralympic Games colleague, Vinicius represents the diversity of the Brazilian people and culture, as well as its exuberant character.



## Seúl 1988



It was the official mascot of the 1988 Summer Olympics, his name is Hodori and which were held in the city of Seoul.

It is a tiger, a very popular animal. The mascot features different colors: Orange and black.
